STATE OF THE CAMPUS

When Proposition 209 passed in 1996, it triggered a precipitous decline in Black student enrollment at UCLA. By 2006, the UCLA freshman class included just 96 Black students, athletes included. That same year, the UCLA Black Alumni Association (UBAA) responded with purpose and urgency by launching the Doby Legacy Scholarship. Since 2006, UBAA has awarded more than \$10 million in scholarships to over 800 UCLA students. A decade later, in 2016, UCLA welcomed the largest Black freshman class in its history—an outcome that speaks directly to the power of sustained investment and collective action.

Despite ongoing political and systemic challenges, UCLA today enrolls the largest number of Black students in the UC system and one of the largest Black undergraduate populations outside of an HBCU. This progress is due in large part to the unwavering commitment of longtime donors like you, whose generosity to UCLA and the UCLA Black Alumni Association has helped open doors, create opportunity, and change lives.

None of this is possible without the continued support of dedicated partners. As we face a new crossroads—marked by federal cuts to higher education and renewed attacks on diversity in college admissions and recruitment—your investment is more critical than ever. Together, we can ensure that access, excellence, and opportunity remain central to UCLA's future.

KEYNOTE ADDRESS



KAREN BASS

43rd and current Mayor of Los Angeles

Mayor Karen Bass has led the nation's second largest city with unprecedented urgency that has delivered results for all Angelenos.

Thousands more unhoused Angelenos have come inside in her first year than the year before, leading to a reported drop in homelessness for the first time in years.

Under the Mayor's leadership, LAPD received record numbers of applicants while homicides and violent crime decreased. 100,000 more city services like pothole repair and graffiti removal have been provided. Thousands of businesses opened. Hundreds of millions of dollars were secured through locking arms with state and federal partners as Los Angeles continues to urgently lead on climate.

Mayor Bass was elected to make change for the people of Los Angeles by breaking with the status quo to deliver for the people of Los Angeles.

Writer | Director | Producer | Bruin Alum

Chris Spencer is a highly accomplished multi-hyphenate creative—director, executive producer, writer, actor, and stand-up comedian—with a career spanning more than three decades.

He is best known as the co-creator and executive producer of the BET/Netflix hit series *Real Husbands of Hollywood*, which originated from a sketch he wrote for the BET Awards. His writing and producing credits include *Grown-ish* and the co-created series *White Famous*, and he has served as head writer for major televised events including the Primetime Emmy Awards, BET, MTV, and ESPYS.

Spencer began his on-screen career as the first host of the syndicated late-night show *Vibe* and has appeared in films such as *Don't Be a Menace* and *The Sixth Man*, as well as series including *Black-ish* and *Being Mary Jane*.

A nationally touring comedian, he has released two Showtime specials and made his feature directorial debut with *Back on the Strip* (2023).
